# CREATION

**“In the beginning, God...”** – God was there at the beginning. He has no beginning and no end. He is infinite, eternal, unchangeable. He is God most high (Genesis 1:1; Psalm 57:2 & 147:5).

**“And God said, let there be light”** – God spoke, and the world came into being. He created out of nothing in the space of six days. When He saw all He made, it was very good (Genesis 1).

**“God created man in His own image”** – God made mankind, male and female. He made them good. Adam was the first man and Eve the first woman. He gave to them souls that could never die (Genesis 1:27 & 2:7).

**God spoke to mankind** – God gave everything in the garden to Adam and Eve to eat and enjoy. They were only forbidden from one tree, the tree of the knowledge of good and evil (Genesis 1:29 – Genesis 2:17).

**God speaks today through His Son in the Bible** – John 1:1-14; Hebrews 1:1-4 & 4:12-13.

# FALL

**Adam Sinned** – Adam and Eve ate the fruit God commanded them not to eat, and they died. The wages of sin is death (Genesis 3:1-15; Romans 5:12 & 6:23).

**All Sinned** – In Adam’s fall, sin entered the world. There is none righteous; no, not one. You have sinned and God knows your sin (Romans 3:10-23).

**Death** – The day that Adam sinned, death entered the world. People die because of sin.

**Judgment** – All who do not repent and believe will perish for their sin (Mark 1:15; John 3:14-18).

**Destination** – Hell is a real and terrible place. You must flee from Hell (Jude 1:7).

**We plead with you:** Repent therefore and be converted that your sins may be blotted out (Acts 3:19).



# REDEMPTION

**Jesus Christ** – He came into the world to save sinners (John 3:14-16; 1 Tim. 1:15).

**He Lived a Perfect Life** – Jesus never sinned in the slightest way (2 Cor. 5:21).

**He Died a Cursed Death** – Jesus was made a curse and died on the cross (Gal. 3:13).

**He died to pay for sin** (Heb. 9:26 – 28)

**He died to forgive sinners** (Eph. 1:7)

**He died to reconcile sinners** (Col. 1:2)

**He died so His people may live** (Gal.3:26)

**He Rose From the Dead** – On the 3<sup>rd</sup> day, just as He said (Matt. 28:6).

**He Ascended** – To heaven where He sits at the right hand of the Father (Acts 1:9-11).

**He Rules** – Jesus is King of kings, and Lord of lords (1 Tim. 6:15; Rev. 19:16).

**He Calls You** – “Look unto Me and be saved, all you ends of the earth! For I am God and there is no other” (Isaiah 45:22).
